Our Fire District:

Orcas Island Fire and Rescue is currently staffed by an Interim Fire Chief, Interim Finance Manager, Volunteer Coordinator, Interim Public Records Clerk, and 4 Shifts with a staffing goal of 1 FireMedic and 1 Firefighter/EMT. OIFR has over 50 volunteers who fill various roles from EMT, FF, Tender Operator, Wildland, and Rescue Technicians.

Our District's response area is all of Orcas Island (57.3 square miles) locally known as "the Gem of the San Juans" https://www.visitsanjuans.com/orcas-island and serves a supportive permanent population of 6,000 with a peak summer population of 12,000.
